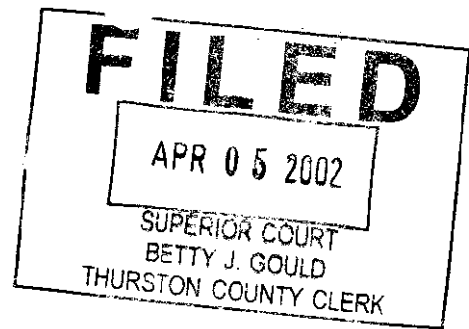

NOTICE AND SUMMONS OF HEARING

- 1.1 You are notified that a petition, a copy of which is attached to this notice, has been filed with this Court, requesting approval of a petition alleging that the named Minor is a Child in Need of Services (CHINS).
- 1.2 You are summoned to appear at a hearing on this petition on:
THURSDAY, APRIL 11, 2002 at 2:00 PM am/pm at
Thurston County Family and Juvenile Court, 2801 32nd Ave. SW, Tumwater, Washington, 98512.
- 1.3 The purpose of this hearing is to hear and consider evidence related to the petition.
- 1.4 If you do not appear, **THE COURT MAY ENTER AN ORDER IN YOUR ABSENCE**, approving the Petition as filed and placing the Minor in an out-of-home placement.

ADVICE OF RIGHTS AND CONSEQUENCES

- 2.1 A lawyer will be appointed for the Minor.
- 2.2 The parents of the Minor have a right to be represented by a lawyer at the hearing.

- 2.3 All parties have a right to present evidence at this fact-finding hearing.
- 2.4 **Where a Child in Need of Services (CHINS) petition has been filed,**
- 2.4.1 be advised that if the Court approves the petition, the Minor will be ordered to either reside in an out-of-home placement subject to the terms of the court order, but the parents will not be relieved of financial responsibility of the Minor.
- 2.4.2 be advised that the Court may, instead of approving the CHINS petition and ordering out of-home placement, approve an At-Risk Youth (YAR) petition filed by the parents, dismiss the CHINS, or Order the Department of Social and Health Services to review the case to determine whether a Dependency petition under RCW Chapter 13.34 should be filed.
- 2.5 In response to a CHINS petition, the parents have the right to file an At-Risk Youth (YAR) petition under RCW Chapter 13.32A, a guardianship petition under RCW Chapter 11.88, or a Dependency petition under RCW Chapter 13.34. The parents also have the right to submit an application for admission of the Minor to a treatment facility for alcohol, chemical dependency, or mental health treatment. The parents may seek Court review of a decision not to pursue involuntary commitment of the Minor for alcohol, chemical dependency, or mental health treatment under RCW Chapters 70.96A and 71.34.
- 2.6 If a Dependency petition under RCW Chapter 13.34 has been filed before the above-scheduled hearing, the Court will be unable to grant either a CHINS or YAR petition.

Comes now the Prosecuting Attorney in and for Thurston County, Washington, and charges the defendant with the following crime:

COUNT I - UNLAWFUL MANUFACTURE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN PRESENCE OF MINOR WITH SCHOOL BUS STOP ENHANCEMENT WHILE ARMED WITH A DEADLY WEAPON. RCW 69.50.401(a)(I)(ii), RCW 9.94A.128; RCW 69.50.435(a)(3); RCW 9.94A.310(3)(b); RCW 9.94A.125



Synopsis: A male contacted his daughter by telephone and threatened to kill her and burn down the house were she was staying. A short time later, the male contacted his daughter at her residence, where he was arrested for outstanding warrants.

Narrative: Tumwater units were dispatched to 223 Lark St SW for a reported Harassment clear. The reporting party, Kirsten Harris, advised she would meet police in front of 1275 S 2nd Ave SW.

I arrived in the area with Lt D Stevens. I contacted Harris. She told me the following: She was seeking custody of a friend's daughter, Starcia Ague. Starcia father, Daniel Ague-Masters, was disputing the custody arrangement. Harris told me that Ague-Masters had extensive drug history. Starcia's mother and Harris were working with CPS to resolve the matter.

On 04-03-02 around 1910 hours, Ague-Masters called his daughter, Starcia, at Harris' residence. Ague-Masters was very angry when he called regarding the custody issue. Ague-Masters told Starcia that he was coming to get her. He told Starcia he would slit her throat and pour gas on Harris' home and torch it if she did not go with him. Starcia told Harris what her father had said. Starcia was visibly scared according to Harris, so she had Starcia go to a friend's house nearby. Harris contacted police.

Harris contacted Starcia by phone and had her respond to our location. Starcia told me the following: She confirmed that her mother had allowed her to stay with Harris. Starcia confirmed that her father had called her and he was angry. Ague-Masters told her he was coming over to get her. He told her not to tell Harris or he would kill her. She denied that he

said he would slit her throat. He added that if Harris tried to stop him from taking Starcia he would pour gas on her house and torch it. Starcia said that her father had a history of being violent. She said that she feared for her and Harris' welfare. She told Harris what had happened when she got off the phone with her father. Starcia then went over to a friend's house to avoid contact with her father.

Statements were given to Harris and Starcia. They advised the statements would be forthcoming.

A warrants check showed Ague-Master to have outstanding warrants for Felony Harassment, Malicious Mischief 2, and Assault DV. Lt. Stevens and I checked the area for Ague-Masters and cleared the scene.

Around 1959 hours, We were dispatched to Harris' house. The caller advised Ague-Masters was at the residence.

Lt. Stevens and I arrived at the scene. I contacted Ague-Masters standing at the gate to Harris' property. He was detained until the warrants were confirmed. A pat down was done on Ague-Masters person. He told me he had a pocket knife in his right front coverall pocket. The knife (approx. a 2" to 2 1/2" blade) was recovered and later logged into evidence at the station (see attached evidence form). The warrants were confirmed and Ague-Masters was placed under arrest on the warrants.

I transported Ague-Masters to TCSO Jail. While in route to the jail, I read Ague-Masters his Miranda Rights, per card. He acknowledged his rights and waived them. He admitted to calling his daughter and telling her that he was coming to get her. He admitted to telling Starcia not to tell Harris. He denied making any threats to do harm to Harris' or his daughter in any way.

Upon arriving at the jail he was booked for the warrants. The additional charge of Felony Harassment-DV will be forwarded to the Prosecutor's Office for review.
