**III. ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that: ~~the visitation schedule until further order of the court or changes agreed with GAL shall be as follows: Every Friday afternoon for about 6 hrs (after school until 8:00pm, or 1:00-1:30 to 7:00-7:30) at Dawna's home, with no one present except Dawna, Starcia, Chanelle & Faith. Dawna, with Starcia's help, will prepare dinner during the visit. Dawna will be at home during the entire visit. Kirsten will bring Starcia and pick her up after the visit. The GAL may visit during the visit. Visitation may be changed at the request of either party with the agreement of the GAL. Both parties are subject to handover UAs. Any restrictions on Starcia imposed by Kirsten shall not affect or change or cancel the~~ visit. ~~Dawna will enforce consequences imposed by Kirsten.~~ ~~shall be at the discretion of Ms. Harris~~
