I went to contact a friend of the family in re a relatives illness, and upon knocking was told to come in, much to my surprise my husband was in the house with the wife of the family friend - I believe Troy panicked believing he had been "caught" and became explosive - he grabbed me and threw me back out the door & violently down some concrete steps without provocation. My injuries are documented and SUBSTANTIAL.

This case is currently being investigated by detective Louise Adams of the TCSO - She has urged me for my safety to come here and attempt to protect myself - The photos of my injuries & her report are not complete as of this AM - Mr Lee obtained an TMORAH & has incriminated himself by changing his story, Mr Lee's TMORAH is now part of the evidence in this investigation 08-282-1 is the case #.

Troy has cracked my head open, broken my tail bone (couldn't sit down properly for 5 years, pulled my hair, gotten "in my face" in a threatening and domineering way - I have SCARS due to injury from his past abuse Troy will shoot ANYTHING whether in season or not, and I have been told by him countless times that if I "fuck him over" I will have an accident, or maybe I'll just "commit suicide" Troy has also broken/destroyed my personal effects, physically attacked family members and even gave my daughter a black eye.

It is my belief Troy is once again using meth.
