Describe the most recent incident or threat of violence and date: 2 days ago I was called by Lynda's friend and she told me Lynda was being abusive to my child - she said Lynda was angry at me for not "sistering" her, and she was taking out on the baby. I then began to recall certain strange incidences & bruises on my baby, and an overall change in my baby's behavior. These are two prior incidents that come to mind -

One is where I could hear my baby screaming & I went to the door - when I opened it Lynda looked shocked, started stammering, and said "It was an accident - I didn't mean to hurt her" The other time I was asleep on the couch & the baby started screaming when I bolted up, Lynda was stammering and saying "I think I broke her arm" Lynda in front of two witnesses, upon being questioned, did admit to being cruel to my daughter, but would claim she did not mean to hurt her.

STATEMENT: (Continued)

I just want the court to be aware of the fact that Lynda has already admitted to wrong doing. We just don't know what yet - The witnesses are writing statements now. She also admitted in front of witnesses - that I have only helped her - have never hurt her - and supported her more than anyone.

I believe she is here because she fears the CPS investigation and is trying to create subterfuge in regard to what the facts are.

Lynda is aware that I had planned to leave by August 1 2010, although my planned stay was until September 1 2010. Lynda owes me money - this is admitted - yet refuses to pay or sign a contract promising payment.

At this time I have no available funds in which to move my daughter and I safely. Lynda, however, does have an extended support system, and in fact the woman with her today is her former landlord-roommate.
