II. FINDINGS OF FACT

Upon the basis of the court record, the court FINDS:

2.1 NOTICE AND BASIS OF PERSONAL JURISDICTION OVER THE RESPONDENTS.

All parties necessary to adjudicate the issues were served with a copy of the summons and petition and are subject to the jurisdiction of this court.

The facts below establish personal jurisdiction over the respondents:

The father was served within the State of Washington.

1 The mother was served within the State of Washington.

2 Both parties reside within the State of Washington.

3 2.2 CONCEPTION OF THE CHILD.

4 The mother and father engaged in sexual intercourse resulting in the conception of
5 OLIVIA MIABELLA HARRIS.

6 2.3 PARENTAGE.

7 The court has found JASON MICHAEL FORD to be the Father of OLIVIA MIABELLA
8 HARRIS.

9 A default order has been entered against JASON MICHAEL FORD.

10 2.4 OTHER PARTIES.

11 Does not apply.

12 2.5 COSTS AND FEES.

13 Funds have been expended on behalf of the children and in the litigation of this lawsuit.

14 2.6 BASIS FOR JURISDICTION OVER THE CHILD.

15 This state is the home state of the children because:

16 When the petition was filed, the children had lived in Washington with a parent or person
17 acting as a parent for at least six consecutive months immediately preceding the
18 commencement of this proceeding.

19 2.7 RESIDENTIAL SCHEDULE /PARENTING PLAN.

20 The Primary residence of the child shall be with Mother, who is designated custodian
21 solely for the purpose of other state and federal statutes. The other parent's residential
22 time with the child shall be reserved for later determination upon application of one of the
23 parents.

24 No residential schedule/parenting plan has been proposed; therefore, restatement of RCW
25 26.09.430 through RCW 26.09.480, in the judgment and order determining parentage
26 should be waived pursuant to RCW 26.09.490.

27 Order that the Mother is designated as the custodian of the children, and the children shall
28 reside with the Mother at all times.

2.8 CHILD SUPPORT.

There are children in need of support and child support should be set pursuant to the
Washington State Child Support Schedule. The Order of Child Support signed by the
court on this date and the child support worksheet which have been approved by the court
are incorporated by reference in these findings.

3 3.1 JURISDICTION.

4 The court has jurisdiction to enter an order in this matter.

7 schedule/parenting plan for the children; make provision for the past and current support
8 of the children; and make provision for costs including birth costs, genetic test costs,
9 Guardian Ad Litem fees, health insurance costs and attorneys fees.




