2. You must respond to this summons and petition by filing a written response with the clerk of the court and by serving a copy of your response on the person signing this summons.



3. If this action has not been filed with the court, you may demand that the petitioner file this action with the court. If you do so, the demand must be in writing and must be served upon the person signing this summons. Within 14 days after you serve the demand, the petitioner must file this action with the court, or the service on you of this summons and petition will be void.
4. If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so promptly so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.

5. One method of serving a copy of your response on the petitioner is to send it by certified mail with return receipt requested.
