RE: Bench/working copies for commissioners/judges; Supreme Court of Washington, En Banc Abeda JAFAR, Petitioner, v. William Douglass WEBB, Respondent. No. 87009–8. Decided: May 23, 2013.

I, John Smith, as the movant, am enclosing bench/working copies of the notice to continue in cause numbers 21-4-00443-34 & 21-00452-34 seeking review of my motion to join/intervene under CR 19 & 24 as well as challenge the improper claim to jurisdiction in the matter of a family custody dispute. I'm doing so because I cannot afford the mandatory fees associated with having the clerk's office print out working copies and especially for the required record amounting to almost 2,000 pages. This is both a financial hardship on myself as well as my daughter. In any event, please insure the enclosed working copies reach judge Schaller's bench in a timely manner before 10-1-21.

My understanding of Jafar v. Webb is that an indigent party/litigant cannot be denied meaningful access to the courts even though the Thurston County Superior Court clerk's office provides the paid working copies as a courtesy and it is not statutorily required, per se. Nevertheless, what is required under local court rules, is bench copies of pleadings and documents submitted to the court in family law/probate cases. This is especially burdensome in the case of poor/destitute litigants and effectively serves as a bar to access to the courts inasmuch as it is a convenience to wealthy litigants and an impediment to the poor. Arguably, it also flies in the face of the Jafar v. Webb ruling. Judges have even better access to Odyssey records than attorneys and litigants. That access need not require a printer. Since the court has invested in Odyssey to extend access to the court in a manner that transcends time and distance, printed working copies requirements from the poor should be relaxed just as it has for original submissions via the electronic filing system in Thurston—clearly a large step in the right direction.
