
I. Motion


3.2 In addition to the information in the financial statement, I would like the court to consider the following:

I am currently recovering from surgery and disabled as a result. I am housebound while waiting for my foot to heal which I nearly lost. I am looking at a lot of medical expenses after spending from Nov. 23, 2021 to Dec. 3, 2021 in Olympia's St. Peters Hospital because of a severe infection in my foot and leg. I am diabetic. I have a very limited fixed income and am 75 years old. My income after Part 'B' Medicare premiums are deducted is about \$500/month. I am trying to intervene to prevent a miscarriage of justice affecting myself, my 3 grandchildren, and their mother. I have been unlawfully thwarted from joining under CR 19 & 24 to date—unjustly so. RCW 11.130.270 appears to intend close relatives involved in a guardianship for minors litigation are excused from paying fees which I could not pay in any event.
