SECOND DECLARATION OF MARY M
FOWLER

I, Mary M. Fowler, am over the age of 18 and competent to serve as a witness. I make the following Declaration based on my own personal knowledge:

1. I have owned Farm Boy Drive-In since about 1980. Over the years, probably I have employed more than the most anyone in Maytown. Government shutdowns and proclamations for the first time in our history has put my business on the brink of shutting down and bankruptcy. We are mere weeks away from having to close our doors for good.

2. Once closed every employee will lose their job. We have over a dozen employees.

3. No employee at Farm Boy Drive-In is older than 47 years old, most are much younger and in very good health. There have been no cases of COVID-19 at my business. We strictly take all recommended health and safety precautions.
