I declare,

I have known the Allred's for approximately 7 years. I have been friend to both Rob and Jenna Allred and have worked closely with both in service leadership positions.


On April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 I went to the Shelton High school track to meet Jenna following a track meet. I had offered to help her fill out medical paperwork because of her physical and visual impairment and because Rob refused to help her with it. When I saw Jenna on the other side of the field from where I came in at the entrance, I started across the track- directly in front of the stands to meet her. I was surprised to see Rob and both of her children walking with her toward me. When we met

about halfway, directly in front of the stands, I said hello to everyone. Without responding to me, Rob turned to his children and told them to go wait by the car. I was immediately concerned as his attitude was curt and tense. I was worried he would be cruel to Jenna and was preparing mentally to intercede and lead her away with a comment that we had a lot to go over. I was shocked when instead, he turned on me and began yelling at me words to the effect that he knew all about the lies his wife was telling me and the whole word and she was making me believe he was a monster. My first thought was to calm him down as everyone was staring and I felt humiliated for Jenna. I put my hands out in a gesture of calm and peace and told him I didn't know what he was talking about and that I didn't think that about him. He pointed his finger in my face, moved into my personal space and shouted that he was not cheating on Jenna and denied other things he knew she was spreading everywhere about him. He was tremendously aggressive, standing over me with his face twisted in anger, and became even louder. I became concerned about my own physical safety and told him firmly to stop. He raged for some moments more before stomping off in a temper. I was trembling and Jenna began to cry and apologize for him. Although Jenna had been slowly sharing with me pieces of her private life that caused me to be very concerned about the health of their relationship, this was a shocking revelation as to what Rob is capable of. I had interacted with Rob for years on a regular basis but did not see this side of him until I started helping Jenna in ways he did not want her to be helped. Jenna had not shared with me any of the things he accused her of slandering him of. In fact, she was working hard to understand and repair their relationship at that time. I do not feel safe around Rob and support Jenna's separation from him.


