RESPONSE TO PETITION

Dorcy, Mason County Prosecuting Attorney, and the undersigned Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, responds to the Petition for a Parenting Plan, Residential Schedule and/or Child Support filed in this cause as follows:

- 1. DSHS has provided public assistance monies in the past to one or more parties of this action and arrears are owed to the State of Washington for that period.
- 2. The State of Washington holds by assignment and subrogation any and all right to receive and collect spousal maintenance and any and all child support due and owing recipients of public assistance, including all support due under any temporary order of this court.
