19 The Custody Decree/Parenting Plan/Residential Schedule should be adjusted because a  
20 substantial change in circumstances of the child has occurred. The proposed  
21 modification to the Custody Decree/Parenting Plan/Residential Schedule is in the best  
22 interest of the children. It is a minor modification in the residential schedule that does not  
23 change the residence the children are scheduled to reside in the majority of the time. The  
24 increase is more than 24 full days but less than 90 overnights per year total. The custody  
25 decree/parenting plan/residential schedule does not provide reasonable time with the  
nonprimary residential party.

***It is Ordered:***


