I am the Respondent. The order identified below was granted for a period of time for two years or less. (Respondent: if the order lasts more than two years, do not use this motion. Use form DV 7.050, Respondent's Motion to Modify/Terminate Order for Protection Effective More than Two Years.)

I request that the court modify the:

Order for Protection, filed on AUGUST 2, 0217, which expires on AUGUST 2, 2018.

The order referenced above should be modified/terminated **because**: The Petitioner no longer resides at the shared residence as she has since purchased a new house, located somewhere in Mason, County, and has abandoned the property owned by the parties at 11 E. Susan Place Union, WA 98592. Further, the criminal no contact order that was used as a basis to limit Respondent's prohibition on possessing firearms, concealed pistol license, and other dangerous weapons has been lifted as the criminal case against Respondent has been dismissed and this Court did not make a finding by clear and convincing evidence that Responded has used, displayed, or threatened to use a firearm or other dangerous weapon in a felony or previously been convicted of an offense making him ineligible to possess a firearm under RCW 9.41.040.

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The order referenced above should be modified **as follows**:

Paragraph 5 of the Order should be lifted removing Petitioner's exclusive right to the residence that petitioner and respondent share as Petitioner no longer resides at that residence. Respondent shall be granted access and use of the residence located at 11 E. Susan Place Union, WA 98592. Additionally, the

order should be modified to lift the prohibition on Respondent's ability to possess any firearm, other dangerous weapons, or concealed pistol license.
