This declaration is made by: Lenard Feulner, I am the Respondent in this action. *I Declare*: Ms. Wood continues to file pleadings without following the court rules. This is not the first instance that the Petitioner filed a notice of hearing and declaration without providing a motion. KCLCR77(k)10(B)(ii) states in part ... Domestic Relations motion calendars, including any special set matters under KCLCR 77(k)(9), shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of Court by 4:30 p.m. at least fourteen (14) calendar days before the hearing, *simultaneous with a Motion* and Notice of Hearing and any supporting pleadings (emphasis added). Ms. Wood's declaration doesn't seek relief beyond the word "rejection" in the caption. The court should deny any request being made by Ms. Wood and require that she follow the local court rules for noting a motion along with her Notice of Hearing
