
1 it is **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that:

2 THE STATE OF WASHINGTON shall:

- 3 1. uphold the United States Constitution and its Amendments,
- 4 2. immediately halt any child support enforcement until 12/31/2019,
- 5 3. release all detainees who failed to pay child support from its prisons by 12/31/2018,
- 6 4. vacate all restraining and protection orders between parents and their children issued in the
- 7 absence of equal due process,
- 8 5. amend its statutes to allow for equal due process by 12/31/2019,
- 9 6. allow 50/50 legal shared custody of children,
- 10 7. not interfere in the physical custody of children if there is no limitation on one of the parents,
- 11 8. reform its family courts,
- 12 9. audit its judiciary and bar association,
- 13 10. prosecute against perjury to the maximum allowed by law,
- 14 11. vacate all suppression orders on the media that are in violation of the First Amendment,
- 15 12. notify the press (TV and Newspapers) of the order to release all detainees who failed to pay child
- 16 support from state's prisons by 12/31/2018, and
- 17 13. notify the press (TV and Newspapers) of the order to vacate all restraining and protection orders
- 18 between parents and their children issued in the absence of equal due process by 12/31/2018.


