WSDOT FIRST ANSWER TO WRIT OF

SECTION I

On the date the Writ of Garnishment was issued as indicated by the date appearing on the last page of the writ:

- A. The Defendant was employed by Garnishee Defendant.
- B. The Defendant did maintain a financial account with Garnishee Defendant.
- C. The Garnishee Defendant did have possession of or control over any funds, personal property, or effects of the Defendant.

SECTION II

At the time of service of the Writ of Garnishment on the Garnishee Defendant there was due and owing from the Garnishee Defendant to the above-named Defendant \$11,976.72\*\*

WSDOT FIRST ANSWER TO WRIT OF  
GARNISHMENT FOR CONTINUING LIEN  
ON EARNINGS

1 This Writ attaches a maximum of twenty-five percent of the Defendant's disposable  
2 earnings (that is, compensation payable for personal services, whether called wages, salary,  
3 commission, bonus, or otherwise, and including periodic payments pursuant to a  
4 nongovernmental pension or retirement program).

5 Calculate the attachable amount as follows:

26 \*\*This answer refers to the last pay period and is only an estimate. This writ will run  
11/1/2022 through 12/31/2022.

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
