1 it is **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that:

2 **The United States of America shall:**

- 3 - uphold the United States Constitution, Articles, and Amendments,
4 - reform the United States Code – Title 42 – Chapter 7 [42 U.S.C. §§ 301 to 1397mm] to be in
5 compliance with the United States Constitution, Articles, and Amendments by 12/31/2019,
6 - immediately halt the issuance of all Bills of Attainder,
7 - immediately halt child support enforcement nationwide, and
8 - release all detainees who are imprisoned for failing to pay child support.

9 **The State shall:**

- 10 - uphold the United States Constitution, Articles, and Amendments,
11 - reform its statutes in compliance with the United States Constitution, Articles,
12 and Amendments by 12/31/2019,
13 - allow for equal due process in its courts,
14 - prosecute for perjury to the maximum allowed by law,
15 - reform its family courts,
16 - allow 50/50 *legal* shared custody of children,
17 - not interfere with the *physical* custody of children if there is no limitation on their parents,
18 - defer *physical* custody decision to dispute resolution in the absence of limitations,
19 - immediately halt the issuance of all Bills of Attainder,
20 - immediately halt child support enforcement, and
21 - release all detainees who are imprisoned for failing to pay child support.
