8 **III. JUDGMENT**

9 This matter having come on regularly before the undersigned Judge on the Plaintiff's  
10 Complaint. And since none of the defaulting parties has timely appeared or defended the Plaintiff's  
11 claim, this Court moves to enter a *Default Judgment* against the defendants. Furthermore, this Court  
12 shall retain jurisdiction over this case.

13 It is so **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that:

14 **The United States Government shall:**

- 15 - uphold the United States Constitution, Articles, and Amendments,  
16 - issue a Presidential pardon for all federal offenses done by Americans prior to 11/23/2018,  
17 - arrest any individual who after 01/01/2019 commits an act of corruption against the states or its  
18 people to be tried and prosecuted pursuant to 10 U.S.C. §§ 801 to 946a,  
19 - reform the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. §§ 301 to 1397mm] to be in compliance with the  
20 United States Constitution, Articles, and Amendments by 12/31/2019,  
21 - suspend the Federal Incentives to States under the Child Support Enforcement Program  
22 pending reform of the Social Security Act, particularly Title IV-D and IV-E,  
23 - immediately halt the issuance of all Bills of Attainder,  
24 - prosecute anyone who after 01/01/2019 commits perjury,  
25 - immediately halt child support enforcement nationwide,

- 1 - release all detainees who are imprisoned for failing to pay child support,
- 2 - financially support the homeless, the veterans, and needy Americans over the age of 65,
- 3 - protect the national parks, public lands, and the environment for future generations,
- 4 - protect the United States sovereignty and borders but allow asylum seekers and immigrants
- 5 from all nations to enter after they have been thoroughly vetted,
- 6 - support health, science, education, and infrastructure,
- 7 - abolish federal taxes to help Americans and their families,
- 8 - be a beacon for liberty and justice by protecting human rights and securing an everlasting
- 9 world peace,
- 10 - not endorse, support or make deals with any tyrant nation,
- 11 - not tolerate any hate crimes against any individual, and
- 12 - not infringe upon Americans' rights and freedoms.

13 **The State Governments shall:**

- 14 - uphold the United States Constitution, Articles, and Amendments,
- 15 - reform its statutes in compliance with the United States Constitution, Articles,
- 16 and Amendments by 12/31/2019,
- 17 - allow for equal due process in its courts,
- 18 - prosecute anyone who after 01/01/2019 commits perjury,
- 19 - arrest any state official who after 01/01/2019 commits an act of corruption and hand him/her to
- 20 the Federal Bureau of Investigation to be tried and prosecuted pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 1963,
- 21 - reform its family courts,
- 22 - allow 50/50 *legal* shared custody of children,
- 23 - not interfere with the *physical* custody of children if there is no valid limitation on the parents,
- 24 - defer *physical* custody decision to Alternative Dispute Resolution in the absence of limitations,
- 25 - not issue or renew restraining or protection orders between parents and their children in the



absence of equal due process,

- immediately halt the issuance of all Bills of Attainder,
- immediately halt child support enforcement,
- help reunite American families,
- support health, science, education, and infrastructure,
- audit their courts, bar associations, state officials, child protective services, and elections,
- release all detainees who are imprisoned for failing to pay child support,
- abolish all Debtors' Prisons, and
- not infringe upon Americans' rights and freedoms.


