



\* LSPR 94.03(f) Settlement Conferences. (5) Settlement Conference Statements. Each party shall serve upon the other party and provide to the court a settlement conference statement no later than 14 calendar days prior to the settlement conference, unless the parties agree to a shorter period of time. The shorter period for exchange shall not be less than 7 days before the settlement conference. (6) Sanctions. If a party fails to comply with the provisions of LSPR 94.03(f)(3), (4) & (5), then the Court may immediately impose sanctions not to exceed \$500.
