3 which he projected onto my mother.
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5 In October 2022, my mom came to visit me and my children in California. While she was
6 away from her home from Halloween through Thanksgiving, she realized how much she enjoyed
7 and missed spending time with us, and she decided she wanted to stay with us a little longer. She
8 reached out to Bill to let him know and he did not like that she wanted to extend her visit. He
9 wanted her home to take care of him and his mother. During this time, I saw the struggle she was
10 having with the decision about what she should do. Although, there wasn't any room for
11 discussion with Bill. I have spoken with him many times since my mom first came down here
12 and he wanted me to make her go home. Bill told me he gave my mom ultimatums and then
13 threatened her with divorce if she didn't come home. She expressed to me that information they
14 had discussed during their personal conversations led her to realize that staying away from Bill is
15 what's best for her, so she could work on regaining her own happiness and wellbeing to enjoy her
16 life with her family once again.
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19 Bill decided to cancel the joint credit cards and joint bank accounts when he realized my
20 mom wasn't coming back, and that he had lost control of her. My mom receives a minimal
21 monthly income from her retirement or social security I believe. She also receives monthly food
22 benefits through the State. This does help, but with her medical expenses and the costs associated
23 with maintaining her daily/monthly needs, these amounts are not enough for her to support herself
24 independently. At this time, she isn't able to pay for her medical supplies which Bill used to take
25 care of, her hygiene needs, clothes, groceries, cellphone, gas, and other needs.
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1 While she and Bill were together, she had access to their accounts between the credit cards
2 and bank accounts. She was never limited to a certain amount of spending but despite this, she
3 has always been cautious of her spending, and never made extravagant purchases. Mr. Mother
4 does have significant costs associated with her medical conditions, however.
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6 Now, she doesn't even have the ability to support herself, let alone any additional funds
7 for discretionary spending, to get her grandchildren occasional gifts, or contribute toward our
8 household expenses, which has been difficult and disappointing for her. She has been fully
9 financially supported by Bill for the majority of their relationship, which lasted over 15 years.
10 She didn't foresee things getting to this point, and she needs more assistance than I am able to
11 provide. Currently I am supporting my mom in every way possible, but it has been difficult for
12 both of us. I also have three adult children which I choose to support with some of their household
13 expenses. I have ensured my mother's financial wellbeing for the time being but it is clear to me
14 that this obligation should rest on Bill's shoulders. My mom has medical issues and is older so
15 expecting her to earn an income after all this time without employment is not appropriate in my
16 opinion.
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19 We have discussed her situation on multiple occasions, and I am aware her requests are
20 for monthly spousal support and assistance in coordinating the retrieval of her personal
21 belongings from their residence. Based on the information I know about Bill's financial status,
22 and the fact that he has supported my mother throughout their entire relationship, I believe he has
23 the means and ability to provide her with financial assistance. As for the property, I am willing to
24 assist in making that process as streamlined as possible and will make myself available to help
25 get this taken care of.
